

NOTICE TO FAMILIES WHO HAVE A CHILD OR CHILDREN IN ADVENTURES IN LEARNING CHILD CARE CENTER, INC.

The success of the daycare has attracted and retained well-qualified teachers, who provide safety and learning for all children. Our labor costs will still be approximately 75% of our budget. Food costs, benefits and liability insurance have also increased and these adjustments need to reflect in our rates for families.

The last rate increase was on September 3, 2018. As of September 2, 2019, we will have new rates in some areas. It is a smaller increase this year with a little larger one next year to average out the cost of living. Please see the list below. The “*” areas are where prices will be changing. We will continue to be prudent in the managing of expenses in order to keep costs in line for families who understand what quality childcare means.

Reminder: As stated in the Parent Handbook, any child who attends Adventures in Learning on a part-time schedule, will not receive vacation days. Part-time is considered four days or less. After School and Part Time Preschool children do not receive vacation days.
